

Bible story: I can thank God for God is good.

Every Good and Perfect Gift • *James 1:17; Genesis 1*

Remember this: “Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good.” Psalm 107:1, NIV



Say this: Who is good? God is good!

Activity: God Made Me Charades

What you need: No supplies needed

What You Say:

“Wow, God gives us so many good gifts. God made the Earth and everything in it! What are some of the good things God made? (*Encourage your children to tell you one of their favorite parts of creation.*)

“Those are all wonderful things God created. Now, let’s play a game and act out some of the amazing and wonderful things God made.”

“God made flowers. All flowers start as tiny seeds. Can you make yourself super small like a little seed? (*Demonstrate.*) Have some water and sunshine, little seeds. It’s time to grow. Stand up slowly and stretch your arms up high. (*Pause.*) We’re going to grow big and tall like beautiful yellow sunflowers. (*Pause.*) What a beautiful sunflower you are!”

“Okay, flowers, let’s be an animal this time! I know, let’s move like an elephant! (*Pause.*) You can use your arms to be the elephant’s trunk like this. (*Demonstrate.*) Swing your trunks elephants! (*Pause.*) Good job!” (*Continue with different flowers and animals as desired.*)

“God made the whole world and everything in it. God made every kind of flower and every kind of animal, big and small! Everywhere we look, we can see good gifts that God made because God is good! **Who is good? [Bottom Line] God is good.**”

Prayer:

“Dear God, You make good things because You are good. We want to thank You because You are good. We want to thank You for making so many wonderful things like (*mention some of the items you acted out in the activity*). I especially want to thank You for making (*say your child’s name*). Everywhere we look, we can see that You are good. We love You, God. In Jesus’ name, amen.”
